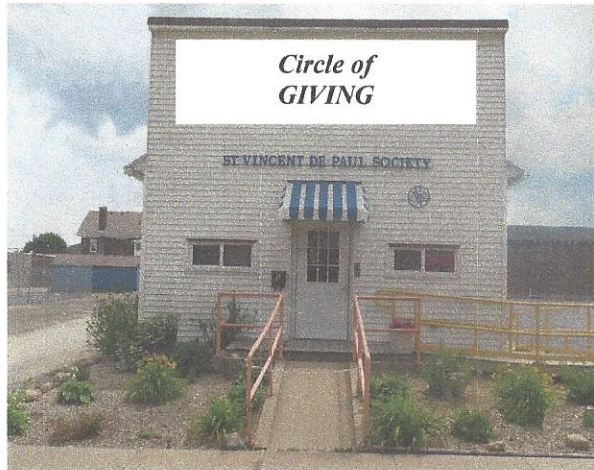
Your partnership with St. Vincent de Paul as an advocate for the needy in our community and all of Whiteside County is greatly appreciated.

- Approximately 90% of all donations are used to support our food and financial aid efforts.
- All families are eligible for a full food order once a week during the pandemic plus fresh produce and commodity items every week.
- The CGH Health Foundation advises us to provide proper nutritional foods.

Services offered last year: 2020

- Each month we provided food to an average of 163 families with 264 adults and 142 dependents.
- Each month we provided financial assistance for rent, utilities, medical prescriptions and gasoline for medical appointments to an average of 25 families.
- Our Systemic Change Outreach Program assisted 28 individuals in their efforts to become more self-sufficient.
- We funded several scholarships at Sauk Valley Community College to support individuals in completing their program of study.
- Your donation made it possible for us to offer \$150 of financial aid per family for a 12-month period and purchase food for our pantry.
